I write today in support of the application from Harley-Davidson Motor Company, Inc. for funding from the Domestic Manufacturing Conversion Grant Program through the U.S. Department of Energy. I urge you to give this application full and fair consideration.

It is my understanding that Harley-Davidson, located in York, Pennsylvania, is seeking \$89 million in funding from the agency to increase their capacity to continue leading the industry in manufacturing electric motorcycles. Since 2014, Harley-Davidson has made significant investments in developing a comprehensive program to lead the global electric motorcycle market. In 2019, Harley-Davidson began their production of electric motorcycles through LiveWire, the organization's publicly traded, 100 percent electric motorcycle company—the first and only of its kind in the Nation.

If awarded, I am told that this funding will support the \$178 million investment necessary to upgrade current electric model quality and to increase production of two existing models. By increasing the number of electric motorcycles available to consumers, Harley-Davidson seeks to address the largest carbon emissions category in its production lifecycle: use and service of its products. Harley-Davidson has explained to me that this project will be supported by highly skilled manufacturing labor and that the project is estimated to generate a total of 150 direct and permanent manufacturing job opportunities and 120 construction jobs.

Harley-Davidson's investment in South Central Pennsylvania is aligned with the intent of the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022, which I supported, to create clean energy jobs, reduce carbon emissions, and build U.S. leadership in clean manufacturing.
