## A BILL

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "East Palestine Health
- 5 Impact Monitoring Act of 2024".

| 4 | (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and      |

5 Human Services (referred to in this section as the "Sec6 retary"), acting through the Centers for Disease Control
7 and Prevention and the Agency for Toxic Substances and
8 Disease Registry, and, as appropriate, the National Insti9 tute of Environmental Health Sciences, shall—

10 (1) award a grant, contract, or cooperative
11 agreement to an eligible entity, for purposes of—

(A) conducting a study on the human
health impacts as a consequence of the February 3, 2023, train derailment in East Palestine, Ohio, and subsequent venting and burning of liquid chemicals;

(B) not later than one year after the date
of the enactment of this Act, and annually
thereafter until submission of the report under
subparagraph (C), submitting to the appropriate congressional committees a report on the
progress of the study under subparagraph (A);
and

24 (C) not later than 5 years after the date25 of enactment of this Act, completing such study

1 and submitting a report to the Secretary, which 2 shall include any appropriate recommendations; 3 (2) submit a report to the appropriate congressional committees on the results of the study and re-4 5 port under paragraph (1); and 6 (3) not later than one year after the date of the 7 enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter until 8 submission of the report under paragraph (2), sub-9 mit to the appropriate congressional committees a 10 report on the progress of the study, as reported by 11 the eligible entity pursuant to paragraph (1)(B). (b) ELIGIBLE ENTITY.—To be eligible for the award 12 13 under subsection (a)(1), an entity shall be a group of public or private institutions of higher education that dem-14 15 onstrates requisite capacity and expertise to carry out the study described in such subsection and that has a physical 16 17 presence in the 2 States directly impacted by the derailment, Ohio and Pennsylvania. 18 19 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-FINED.—In this subsection, the term "appropriate con-20 gressional committees" means the Committee on Heath, 21 22 Education, Labor, and Pensions and the Committee on

Environment and Public Works of the Senate and the 24 Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House of 25 Representatives.

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(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
 authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Health
 and Human Services \$2,000,000 for each of fiscal years
 2024 through 2028 to carry out the study under this sub section.

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
