| Orphans of the Storm Inc | The Orphans of the Storm animal shelter is coping with frequent flooding from a nearby pond and creek, necessitating emergency evacuation of the animals, putting employees and volunteers at risk and causing damage to the building, equipment and records. This funding will contribute to the cost of constructing a new facility on higher ground. | Armstrong, Armstrong County PA | \$100 |
| Animal Care Fund | This project will provide driveway lighting at the Animal Care Sanctuary in Bradford, Pennsylvania, ensuring the safety of the thousands of residents, rescue animals and companion animals they serve each year. | East Smithfield, Bradford County PA | \$69 |
| City of Hazleton | The City of Hazleton will use this funding to consolidate their emergency response services into a new public safety building, providing a more economical operation for the City and producing a better response time by the department. | Hazleton, Luzerne County PA | \$1,650 |
| Jersey Shore Borough | The Borough of Jersey Shore, Tiadaghton Valley Regional Police Department (TVRPD) and the Citizen's Hose EMS/Fire will use this funding to construct a new Regional Public Safety Complex to house all operations associated with the Borough of Jersey Shore, TVRPD, the Citizen's Hose EMS/Fire and the office of Magisterial District Court 29-3-01. | Jersey Shore, Lycoming County PA | \$1,800 |
| The Miller Center for Recreation and Wellness | The Lewisburg YMCA at the Miller Center will use this funding to construct a new child care center in Union County, Pennsylvania, addressing the desperate and growing demand for access to high quality, affordable child care in the region. | Lewisburg, Union County PA | \$1,680 |
| NuVisions Center | The NuVisions Center is requesting funding assistance to renovate and convert a building into a community market and mushroom farm, with a focus on prioritizing employment opportunities for individuals with disabilities. | Lewistown, Mifflin County PA | \$1,000 |
| Oil City Civic Center | The Oil City Civic Center will use this funding to upgrade the failing HVAC system of the historic National Transit Complex in Oil City, PA, providing a safer, more efficient and functional heating and cooling system than the aging system currently in place. | Oil City, Venango County PA | \$152 |

| U.S. Department of Agriculture | The mission of the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Research Service (ARS) facility in University Park (co-located at Penn State) is to support environmentally and economically sustainable farming by improving agroecosystem management.
